

Gender wise distribution of total students First year in college 2021-22



Gender wise distribution of total students third year in college 2021-





Chart-5 Gender wise distribution of total students first year in college 2020-21





Gender wise distribution of total students second year in college 2019-20



Gender wise distribution of total students third year in college2019-20




Chart-11 Gender wise distribution of total students first year in college



2018-19



# Gender wise distribution of total students third year in college 2018-19



Gender wise distribution of total students first year in college 2017-18




Chart-15 Gender wise distribution of total students second year in college 2017-18



# Gender wise distribution of total students third year in college 2017-18






